<u>The John Taylor Foundation for Young Athletes</u> <u>Conditions for applications for Financial Assistance</u>

- 1. In these conditions, the words "you" or "your" refers to the applicant whose name and address are set out overleaf (and/or the applicant's parent or guardian who countersigns the application on your behalf) and the words "we", "us" and "our" refer to the trustees for the time being of The John Taylor Foundation for Young Athletes (the "Foundation").
- 2. These conditions are incorporated into the terms of all grants of financial assistance made by the Foundation and are accepted by you by virtue of your completion of the online application form or submission of a paper application form.
- 3. You are limited to receiving grants up to a maximum total of £1000, any exceptions to this are at the discretion of the Trustees.
- 4. You confirm to us that you are an amateur athlete born and based within the United Kingdom and that all the information you have provided on your application form is true and accurate.
- 5. Applications are considered by our trustees. We would expect to consider and reply to your application within 6 weeks of receipt of your application.
- 6. We may refer your application to the Foundation's Grant Advisory Committee which advises the trustees on applications and which makes recommendations to the trustees. The decision of our trustees (whether of acceptance or refusal) is final. It is our policy not to communicate or enter into correspondence about our reasons for declining support. We are a small charity and that policy supports our view that all our energy and resource should be applied to our main objects.
- 7. If at any time after our approval of your application, the costs to be incurred by you and which we have agreed to fund increase, you must not automatically assume that these increased costs will be covered by our funding to you. You must obtain our prior written approval to any such increased costs before committing us to pay or to be responsible for them.
- 8. A short report (together with supporting photographs, where possible) must be submitted by all successful applicants within 28 days of either the event(s) that we fund taking place or the grant being received, whichever is applicable. The report should be prepared in Microsoft Word and either emailed (enquries@johntaylorfoundation.org.uk) or sent on disk to John Taylor Foundation, 6 Sawrey Court, Broughton-in-Furness, LA20 6JQ. If you do not provide a report you will not be eligible for a further grant.
- 9. In connection with such report and photographs (the "**Information**"), you acknowledge that this information may be used by us for reporting, fund-raising and any other proper purposes of the Foundation (the "**Purposes**"). You confirm to us that the copyright in the Information is legally and beneficially owned by you and you hereby grant us a non-exclusive but irrevocable licence to use the Information for the Purposes and confirm that the Information does not infringe the intellectual property rights of any third party.
- 10. These conditions will be governed by and construed in accordance with English law.
